



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** is entered into by and between:

University of Antique (UA) with postal address at Sibalom, Antique, Philippines represented herein by its president, **DR. PABLO S. CRESPO, JR.** herein referred to as UA;

Daegu University (DU) with the office and postal address at Gyeongsan City, South Korea represented herein by its president, **DR. SOON-JIN PARK**, herein referred to as DU;

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Philippines is working towards ASEAN Integration and internationalization;

WHEREAS, international schools across countries in the world look forward to form collaborative relationship for overseas pre-service teachers internship or practicum;

WHEREAS, the College of Teacher Education-Laboratory High School Main Campus of the University of Antique offers Bachelor of Secondary Education (BSED) programs in English, Mathematics, Filipino, Science, and Social Studies. Its graduates have consistently obtained an above-national passing average in the Licensure Examination for Teachers (LET) over the past years, and the institution maintains only a laboratory school for secondary education;

WHEREAS, both institutions, the University of Antique and Daegu University will collaborate for exchanges of literature, books, and other educational materials;

WHEREAS, both institutions will collaborate for support of educational practicums and other related issues;

NOW THERFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements herein after contained, the parties hereto have agreed as follows:

A. For University of Antique

- 1. To assign student teaching coordinator to coordinate with the Laboratory High School Main Campus and College of Teacher Education on matters pertaining to student internship;
- 2. To select and assign Teacher Consultants in the College of Teacher Education to provide feedback and consultancy in planning of the lesson and providing relevant content to help the student interns improve their comprehension of the subject matter and apply appropriate teaching strategies, and will coordinate with the supervising teachers to check on the interns' progress;
- 3. To select and assign Supervising Teachers in the Laboratory High School will monitor the implementation of the lesson plan, strategies, and class management of the student interns inside the classroom and will report the interns progress to the teacher consultant;
- 4. To closely coordinate with Daegu University, the Laboratory High School and the College of Teacher Education on the needs and concern related to the performance behavior and progress of the student interns;
- 5. To facilitate the enrolment requirements and procedure needed and to be followed by the student interns; and
- 6. To facilitate the student internship needs of the student interns during the duration of their student teaching internship.

B. For Daegu University

- 1. To provide assistance to their student interns in the preparation of documentary requirements for student teaching;
- 2. To coordinate with the concerned units of the university for enrolment and internship requirements, needs and other related issues and concerns of their student interns;
- 3. To facilitate the processing of enrolment of their student interns;
- 4. To provide designated honorarium to Supervising Teachers in the Laboratory High School Teacher and Consultants in the College of Teacher Education;

- 5. To monitor the student interns of their internship performance in the duration of their teaching internship; and
- 6. To coordinate with the concerned units of the university for monitoring and assessment of the practicum performance of their student internship.

The **Memorandum of Agreement** will be in effect for five years after being signed by authorities at both institutions. The content of the agreement can be amended or terminated according to both institutions' discussion and consent.
