

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

ON INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE
BETWEEN

THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION,
COLLEGE OF REHABILITATION SCIENCE,

AT DAEGU UNIVERSITY

AND

THE TEACHERS COLLEGE

AT NATIONAL CHIAYI UNIVERSITY

The College of Education and College of Rehabilitation Science at the Daegu University and the Teachers College at National Chiayi University agree to cooperate on international programs based on the principle of reciprocity.


This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) encourages the exchange of faculty, staff, scholars, students, academic information and materials in the belief that the research and educational processes at both institutions will be enhanced and that mutual understanding between their respective faculty, staff, scholars and students will be increased by the establishment of such exchanges.

1. The institutions agree to promote the following exchange activities based on their respective academic and educational needs:
 - a. exchange of faculty, scholars and students;
 - b. joint research activities;
 - c. exchange of publications, reports and other academic materials and information; and
 - d. sharing of other activities and programs in areas of mutual interest, where such sharing shall result in benefit to both institutions.
2. The implementation of each specific exchange based on this MOU shall be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions. Efforts shall be made by both sides to find financial sources for carrying out the exchange activities.

3. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints or financial obligations be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the MOU.
4. If this MOU is provided in the language of both signatories, both documents have equal validity.
5. This MOU is in force for five years and will be further extended for the same period of length after it is re-agreed by both institutions in this MOU. Meanwhile it is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the MOU at any time, although such action will only be taken after mutual consultation in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to all parties. This MOU shall take effect from the date of the latest signature below.


